Set Targets in Strategic Brief

Collaborate to achieve targets

Verify Outcomes from design through construction to operation

The Standard: Benefits

What will it do differently?

- Operational Energy Target
 - Best in class targets agreed with Scottish Government e.g. newbuild 60% less than 'Typical'
 - Verified in use

Benefits

- Lower carbon emissions including Zero GHG Emissions from Heating
- Better indoor environments:
 - Excellent indoor air quality without cold draughts
 - ☐ Insulation without overheating; Daylighting without glare

How will it do it?

- Carbon performance as core objectives of construction projects
- Articulating targets (energy, indoor environment etc.)
- Energy Modelling to check design is on track to meet targets
- Construction phase checks quality of construction will deliver outcomes
- In Use verify performance and strategy to take all emissions to zero by deadline


